The Organisation:

Roy Castle Fag Ends have been running stop smoking groups on Merseyside since 1994. They have developed this method of running groups continuously which allow clients to self-refer by just turning up, which allows maximum reach of the stop smoking service into communities.

The course:

Running Rolling (no appointment necessary) Groups

Running these groups requires specific skills and ways of working. This two day course introduces participants to these in a fun and interesting way. The training is provided by Melody McGrillis who is one of the people who formed the original Fag Ends Community stop smoking group in 1994.

By the end of this course the participants will:

- Understand the basic structure / principles of running a rolling group.
- Understand the advantages of running groups in such a manner.
- Learn how to overcome any possible barriers.
- Learn how to get the group to work effectively.
- Feel confident in their ability to put into practice+their learning.
- Be able to run the group regardless of number of people present or number of advisors available.
- Be able to work effectively in delivering a quality service
- Know how to structure a group to suit this type of programme
- Be able to deal with busy Groups!
- Know how to deal with disruptions / new clients arriving
- Have learnt how to prepare for groups
- Understand the optimum room lay out for this type of group
